**About:** Youth Arts in the Parks is presented by Miami-Dade County Department of Cultural Affairs and Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Disability Services, in partnership with Arts for Learning/Miami. Youth Arts in the Parks is an inclusive, socially-oriented arts program for children and youth with and without disabilities.

This fun and educational program teaches kids of all abilities visual arts, creative movement and expression, or theater/improvisation in a social setting. Classes are led by professional artists/art teachers, certified instructors and disability experts. No prior experience is required. Participating students must be residents of Miami-Dade County.

**Space is Limited!** Registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Submitting a registration form does not guarantee a spot in the program. **Only registration forms that are fully completed and submitted with payment in full will be accepted for enrollment. Program registration fees are non-refundable.**

**Registration Deadline:** All registration forms must be received by **Friday, January 12, 2018. Payment must be made in full by 12 noon on January 19th in order to secure your child's registration in the program.**
