Camp Staff Guidelines

• Constantly be aware of each camper's health and safety during the day.

• Make sure each camper receives the proper orientation to the group, the activities, and the basic rules and procedures at camp and during their scheduled routines.

• Be aware of each camper's physical and emotional needs by reviewing the camper's health history.

- Deal with camper behavior through positive methods.
- Report ALL injuries, no matter how minor, to the First Aid Specialist.
- Remain with your group at all times AND participate in all activities.

• Protect the privacy and personal information of the campers and their families.

- Cell phone usage only during breaks and not within an ongoing camp activity
- Appropriate Dress:
 - Shorts at least mid-thigh length.
 - Closed-toe shoes to avoid injuries
 - No cut-off or mid-rise shirts
 - o Small studs or small hoops to avoid injuries
 - Well-groomed hair
 - During water activities, females must wear whole piece swimsuits or water/dri-fit/t-shirts to cover stomach area
 - Be punctual.
 - Establish an open-line of communication with parents, staff and supervisors
