Changes made to the environment, and/or instruction based on an individual student's strengths and needs

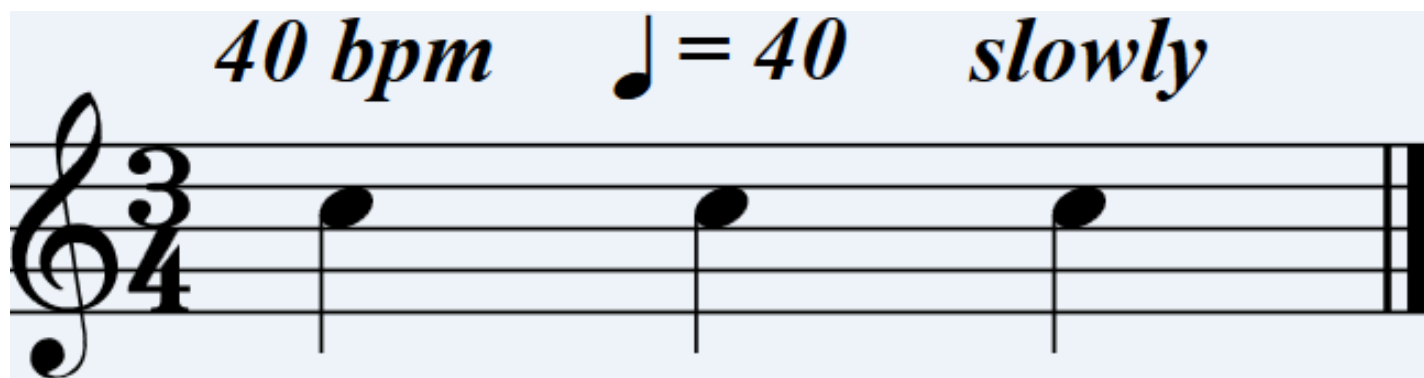
