In light of the uncertainty surrounding the impact of COVID-19 on public programs scheduled for June 1 – September 30, 2021, each proposal was evaluated based upon both the quality of the application and the ability to satisfactorily address each of the evaluation criteria, as stated in the program's guidelines. Before releasing grant funds to organizations, the Department will assess the feasibility of the grantees safely presenting public programs in identified venues and spaces; if necessary, the Department is prepared to exercise appropriate contractual flexibility to include virtual programs and other program delivery strategies, as may be necessary.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Council approve the funding of 48 grants for a total of \$825,000.00 for the FY 2020-21 Summer Arts & Science Camps for Kids (SAS-C) Grants Program.

## **BACKGROUND**

The FY 2020-21 Summer Arts & Science Camps for Kids (SAS-C) Grants Panel, chaired by Councilor Monty Trainer, convened on Thursday, February 25, 2021 to review 48 applications requesting a total of \$1,734,390. The Panel recommended funding 48 applications for a total of \$825,000. The Summer Arts & Science Camps for Kids (SAS-C) Grants Program was created as a joint initiative of the Miami-Dade County Department of Cultural Affairs and The Children's Trust. The objective of the SAS-C Grants Program is to grant funding to non-profit organizations that will provide underserved children in Miami-Dade County with opportunities to attend high quality cultural arts or science summer camp programs at little or no cost. Funding through the SAS-C Grants Program is intended to augment existing camp programs, providing more children with the opportunity to participate in cultural arts and science summer camps. Applicants to this program must have a minimum one-year track record of providing high quality, arts or science summer camp programs for children and/or youth in Miami-Dade County.

The Panel specifically evaluated each applicant organization based on the following competitive review criteria: 1) impact, 2) artistic/scientific merit, 3) management capability, and 4) reach/priority considerations.

Priority attention for evaluating applications was given to:

- projects that addressed children whose ability to participate in such programs may be limited by geography, economics or disability;
- projects in which unduplicated children underwritten by SAS-C funding will attend the camp program for four weeks or more; and

- projects offering expanded programs and/or capacity in order to reach a broader population of underserved children.

Attached is a list describing the projects recommended for funding.

Funding for the Summer Arts & Science Camps for Kids Grants Program is derived from funds granted to the Department from The Children's Trust (\$825,000). All grant award recommendations are contingent upon approval by the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners and Mayor.
